Thanks you for inquiring about the Skye Terrier Foundation's NO KILL Rescue Program. The Skye Terrier Foundation is a not for profit, 501©3, organization founded in 1998 by the Skye Terrier Club of America to address Skye Terrier welfare, health and rescue matters. We have been rescuing and re-homing Skye Terrier for 12 years and have successfully placed over 150 Skyes into new loving homes. These special Skyes found themselves either orphaned or abandoned through no fault of theirs and in desperate need of finding new, loving and permanent families. The majority of our "orphans" are found abandoned in animal shelters across the U.S and Canada, the rest are given up by families who are no longer able to keep them. Our experience has shown that these Skyes make wonderful pets and companions and do adjust very well to their new families.

Each Skye who enters our Rescue loop is carefully evaluated in terms of temperament, veterinary status, and emotional needs. All of our Skyes are spayed or neutered, are current on vaccinations, have a fecal test, heartworm test, are on heartworm preventative and are micro-chipped for identification before being placed. Because of the expenses that we incur, at the time of adoption, we ask for a voluntary donation to help our Skyes in distress and to be able to continue our good work.

Please complete the enclosed application so that we can better get to know you, your family, and your lifestyle. This information will assist us in matching your

family with one of our Skyes. Our goal is to find a permanent, loving home for each of these very special Skyes. After a careful review of your application, we may ask for a personal interview with one of our volunteers. It is difficult to estimate how long it will take to find 'just the right' Skye for you. If you have any questions or wish to periodically check on Skye availability, please e-mail or call us. These contacts will let us know you are still interested.
